Dear Pharmacist,

On behalf of Merck & Co., Inc. and the Merck Vaccine Division, I am pleased to inform you of a new program – the Merck Adult Vaccination Program – designed to expand access to adult vaccines through pharmacies and vaccine service providers. Recognizing that pharmacists play a valuable role in advancing the health of their community by helping to prevent illness and disease through vaccinations, this program is just one example of our company's commitment to developing initiatives that strengthen health care infrastructure.

A major component of the Merck Adult Vaccination Program is a directory for interested healthcare professionals to use when looking for community pharmacies that provide vaccination services for Merck adult vaccines within a geographic area. Any community pharmacy interested in participating and that agrees to the terms and conditions of the Program may enroll.

Once enrollment is completed and your pharmacy's information is verified, the Merck Adult Vaccination Program will provide the following:

- A listing of your location as a vaccination site in an easy-to-access directory will be made available to interested healthcare professionals. The directory will be available in August 2006 and will initially be accessed by calling the Merck National Service Center at 1-800-Merck-90. A searchable website(s) is scheduled for launch in fall 2006.
- Promotion of the Merck Adult Vaccination Program participant listing by Merck professional sales representatives to interested healthcare professionals.
- Resources that may include information and reference material to help develop vaccination protocols, patient education, website addresses to obtain product information, and vaccine storage and handling information.

To enroll in the Merck Adult Vaccination Program, please read the accompanying "Terms and Conditions for Participation in the Merck Adult Vaccination Program." Complete the "Participant Registration Form" and sign the terms and conditions of the Merck Adult Vaccination Program, return the entire completed form and executed terms and conditions to Merck via fax to (215) 616-5677. To register multiple pharmacy locations, please complete the Merck Adult Vaccination Program Participant Location Spreadsheet and return it with your form. Upon Merck's approval of your application, you will be sent acknowledgement of your acceptance in the Merck Adult Vaccination Program and receive your Merck Adult Vaccination Program resources. If your pharmacy is part of a larger chain or institutional organization, please contact your headquarters to determine whether or not your company is participating or planning to participate in the Merck Adult Vaccination Program prior to submitting your application.
