As January 1, 2008, approaches, Wellpoint NextRx as part of our commitment to communicating changes to our network of pharmacies, would like to review some important information moving forward.

1. **WellpointNextRx.com is live!** All payer sheet information, pharmacy agreements, claim information and more is available. Once on the Web site [www.WellpointNextRx.com](http://www.WellpointNextRx.com) go to Provider Services and select the appropriate link.

## 2. Medicare Part D member transition 1/1/08

- Medicare Part D Members will migrate from BIN 610053 to BIN 610575. CA, GA, and TX should pay particular attention to this information. **Part D 1-888-549-5748** Customer Service
- Members will receive new cards with BIN 610575
- Claims submitted to BIN 610053 will reject with messaging “submit to BIN 610575”.
- A pharmacy may request their customer impact list by sending a request to [APM.Retail.Network@Wellpoint.com](mailto:APM.Retail.Network@Wellpoint.com) with “Part D Transition” in the heading.
- MA-PD plans not transitioning include Blue Cross Blue Shield of Rhode Island, Blue Cross of Idaho Health Services Inc. and Community Care of Oklahoma HMO Inc.

## 3. Vaccine Administration: covered by Medicare Part D

- Beginning Jan. 1, 2008, vaccine administration fees for select vaccine products will be covered under Medicare Part D. Previously only the vaccine was covered.
- The pharmacy needs to have administration capability included in its participating pharmacy contract in order to process administration claims. - On the NCPDP Version 5.1 standard request payer sheets, the segment to complete for vaccine administration is DUR/PPS.
